About the Campaign	A NEW campaign that in being implemented in every parish, across the Diocese, starting in July 2017 and running through 2019. The objective of the campaign is to: raise funds that will help bolster your parish community; provide an opportunity for you to spread the joy of the Gospel; and, lead more of your friends, family members, and neighbors back to Mass.	The Annual Bishop's Appeal provides the financial resources which makes it possible for the Church to meet the current fiscal year's operating needs in serving the People of God in 14 counties of our Diocese.
Financial Goal	Through all the parish campaign funds combined, we seek to raise a total of \$45 million.	Each year we aim to raise at least 70% of the current fiscal year's operating budget. In 2016, The Bishop's Appeal raised more than \$7.5 million.
Where will my donation go?	 Funds raised though Re-Igniting Our Faith will be allocated as follows: 70% of funds raised through your parish's campaign will be retained by your parish for critical needs and to ignite the spirit and the joy of the Gospel. 30% of funds raised will be allocated to grow ministries and programs which serve additional parish needs. 	The Bishop's Appeal supports ministries, and programs, many of which provide essential services to the 126 parishes of our Diocese.
What programs will I be supporting?	 70% (\$31.5 million) parish allocation – Your local parish leaders will have the freedom and flexibility to invest 70% of parish funds raised, as appropriate to create or enhance programs and resources that will build a more dynamic faith community. Each parish will have its own plan. 30% (\$13.5 million) ministry allocation – Ministries that will be supported through Re-Igniting Our Faith are outlined in more detail on the subsequent pages. 	All proceeds from The Bishop's Appeal are distributed to the various ministries, based on budgetary needs, such as: Catholic Charities, Diocesan Vocations, Catholic Schools, and many other large-scale programs which a single parish could not fund or operate on its own. What is the purpose and intended impact for each of the ministries?	 Critical Funding for Retired Clergy Priests continue to serve our parishes well beyond retirement. Retired priests require adequate income and housing. Current funds do not meet the needs of the increasing number of retired clergy. Priest pensions are not assisted by The Bishop's Appeal. Enhanced Support for Vocations Priestly vocations have increased dramatically. As numbers of aspirants and seminarians rise, more funds are required for their formation and education. The Bishop's Appeal funds no longer meet the growing needs for preparing our future priests.
